The Freddie Steady 5's new CD, *Tex Pop*

Austin, Texas--The Freddie Steady 5 is back! *Tex-Pop* is just that--a powerful package of jangly, Beatlesque pop with a Texas touch. Texas Music Hall-of-Famer Freddie Krc (rhymes with search) has pounded out a steady beat on the drums behind renowned singer/songwriter Jerry Jeff Walker and dozens of other artists in the studio (including Carole King, Pink Floyd's Roger Waters, and the Small Faces' Ronnie Lane). All along, he has also been out front on his own projects, including a country band called Freddie Steady's Wild Country, a punk/pop band of legendary influence called The Explosives, and his Western folk rock outfit, The Shakin' Apostles.

The Freddie Steady 5 has been his most personal project to date, a vehicle for the kind of real rock and roll that had first captured his imagination as a kid when he saw the Beatles perform on Ed Sullivan. Krc was a Texas kid (still is) who found inspiration in that British beat, which made it only fitting that the first concert he ever saw was the Tex-Mex group with the British name, the Sir Douglas Quintet.

You'll hear the spirit of Sir Doug throughout *Tex Pop*, just as you'll hear the welcomed return of Freddie's best pal and musical collaborator, Cam King. King's blistering guitar work and brilliant song-writing skills also powered the Explosives, which the two have recently revived for supporting the return of their mutual musical hero, Roky Erickson.

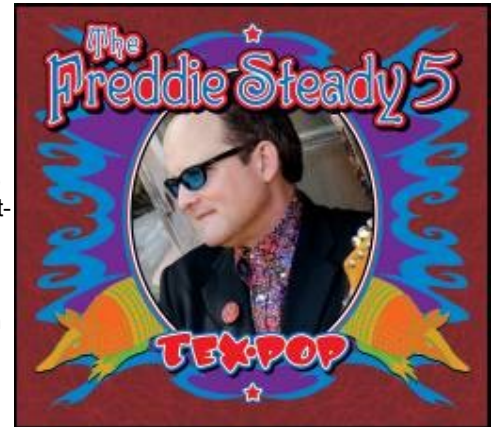

The CD cover art brings an appropriate pop art feel to the whole project, designed by San Francisco-based artist, Dennis Loren, creator of some of the most important images in rock history. Loren is responsible for concert posters of everyone from Jimi Hendrix to Bob Dylan, and he recently designed the cover art for the most anticipated album in modern music history, Brian Wilson's *Smile*.

The Freddie Steady 5 is the real deal, garage rock and roll with a hook, and the multi-faceted story of Freddie Steady Krc has plenty of hooks of its own. Krc is a renaissance musician, with a rich story to tell from a life in music. Beyond his work with the FS5 and Erickson, Krc is also currently busy mentoring and producing a group of teenagers. Jenny Wolfe and the Pack are his labor of love, with an obvious spiritual link to his own youthful rock and roll passion.

Krc is available for features and interviews, and the Freddie Steady 5 is ready to rock the house, in Texas and beyond.--*Rush Evans*
